

AMEND BYLAW
TOWN OF BIENFAIT
BYLAW NO. 3 (2007)
A BYLAW TO AMEND

The Council of the Town of Bienfait in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

That Bylaw No. 8 (2006) A Bylaw of the Town of Bienfait for Licensing Dogs and Cats and Regulating and Controlling Persons Owning or Harboring Dogs and Cats is amended:

- 1. In section 1, by adding after subsection m): new subsection n) “ “Restricted Dog” means Pit Bull Terrier, American Pit Bull Terrier, Pit Bull, Staffordshire, Bull Terrier, American Staffordshire Terrier, Doberman Pinscher, Rottweiler, Wolf Hound, Wolf Cross, Coyote Cross, or any dog of mixed breeding which includes any of the aforementioned breeds which can be identified through its physical characteristics by a Veterinarian licensed to practice in Saskatchewan. An owner, possessor or harbourer of a restricted dog shall obtain and keep a restricted license of his/her dog (s). The license for a restricted dog shall be Twenty-five (\$25.00).”**
- 2. In Part 1, Subsection 4, by adding “The license year of the dog or cat shall be from the first day of January to the thirty-first day of December of the same year.” after “cat owned by the owner.”**
- 3. In Part IV, subsection 25, by adding “The owner or possessor of a kennel whose kennel is registered in the Registrar of The Canadian Kennel Club may in lieu of procuring a license for each dog as hereinbefore required, pay the Town a sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) as the license for all dogs in such kennel.” after “relating to the operation of kennels within the Town.”**
- 4. In Part IV, by adding after subsection 32: new subsection 33 “No person within the Town of Bienfait shall harbour or keep more than three (3) dogs on any one property. If an owner fails or refuses to comply with the provisions of this section, s/he shall be subject to a penalty of Twenty-five (\$25.00) for each animal exceeding the limit, and which may be amended from time to time by resolution of Council.”**
- 5. In Schedule “A” by striking out from # 1 (dogs/cats not neutered) \$110.00 and substituting \$15.00**

6. By adding SCHEDULE “C” TO BYLAW 8 (2006)

3. Failure to confine a restricted dog in a proper enclosure when on premises of the owner, possessor or harbourer	
1st Offence	\$250.00
Subsequent Offences	\$500.00
4. Fail to muzzle a restricted dog off the premises of the owner, possessor or harbourer	
1st Offence	\$50.00
Subsequent Offences	\$100.00
5. Failure to prevent a restricted dog from running at large	
1st Offence	\$250.00
Subsequent Offences	\$500.00
